<ul> <li>Monthly case manager visits</li> <li>Arrange transportation</li> <li>Install safe navigation aids (ramps and safety bars)</li> <li>Coordinate homecare and healthcare (nurse and doctor visits, medication, medical equipment, food/nutrition)</li> <li>Purchase food, toiletries, supplies, clothing</li> <li>Exterminations, deep cleanings, hoarding clean-outs, and repairs</li> <li>Advocate for renters – landlord/tenant issues, address violations, pay back rent</li> <li>Homelessness / eviction prevention</li> <li>Ensure home appliances and furniture in good working condition: bed, mattress, heating, boilers, kitchen equipment, fans, air conditioning, etc.</li> <li>Prevent and eliminate emotional / physical / sexual abuse</li> <li>Seek orders of protection and temporary restraining orders</li> <li>Emergency moves to safer environment</li> <li>Arrange for home / cellphone / internet access</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Reconcile bank statements</li> <li>Pay bills and prepare budgets for daily living and monthly expenses</li> <li>Arrange and deliver personal allowance</li> <li>Marshal and safeguard assets, income and investments</li> <li>Secure all benefits / entitlements</li> <li>Negotiate major debts</li> <li>File personal and/or property taxes, pay tax liens</li> <li>Prevent and investigate financial exploitation and fraud</li> <li>Reverse mortgage strategies</li> <li>Protect personal property</li> <li>Medicaid planning</li> <li>Establish special needs trusts (SNTs)</li> <li>File motions to obtain property powers, if necessary</li> <li>Poroperty-Owning Clients:</li> <li>Property maintenance, major repairs</li> <li>Purchase property insurance</li> <li>Act as landlord (single / multiple dwellings) - manage rental units, tenants, collect arrears</li> <li>Evict tenants / remove squatters</li> <li>Pay utilities and property taxes</li> <li>Oversee property sales</li> <li>Avoid foreclosure</li> <li>Analyze reverse mortgage liens (red- flags of elder fraud)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Oversee homecare and medical care, manage medication</li> <li>Make major medical decisions and prevent painful and unnecessary procedures and surgeries</li> <li>Nutritional planning</li> <li>Secure all public benefits and entitlements</li> <li>Medicare/Medicaid enrollment</li> <li>Encourage and arrange for substance abuse and mental health therapy and counseling</li> <li>Advocate for physical, occupational and speech therapy</li> <li>Encourage socialization and participation in community day programs and senior centers</li> <li>Ensure adequate care is provided in nursing homes and institutions</li> <li>Motion to expand guardian of person powers, if necessary</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Secure access to appropriate housing (apartment, home or assisted living)</li> <li>Maximize income and benefits</li> <li>Coordinate client control of finances and choice of health care providers when appropriate</li> <li>Petition for reduction of guardianship powers, if appropriate</li> <li>Employment readiness and preparation: coordinate life skills and vocational training</li> <li>Reduce isolation (home care, day programs, senior centers, social programs, family and friends)</li> <li>Arrange for home / cellphone / internet access</li> <li>Manage pet ownership and adequate care</li> <li>Coordinate travel / vacations / day trips</li> <li>Identify client's unique needs and preferences, and provide when possible</li> <li>Seek language-appropriate services providers (home health aides, doctors, senior centers)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Discharge planning from nursing homes and hospitals to homes, apartments and assisted living facilities</li> <li>Maintain financial security, budgets, bill-paying, housing and benefits to support client preference for living arrangements</li> <li>Secure and coordinate homecare and medical care</li> <li>Analyze Reverse Mortgage options to keep client in their home</li> <li>Negotiate and pay household debt (Con Edison, etc.)</li> <li>Maximize opportunities for socialization in the community</li> <li>Explore language-appropriate facilities and services, as per language and cultural background</li> <li>Seek services to keep client in least restrictive setting (e.g. Meals-On-Wheels)</li> <li>Petition for Fair Hearings to address benefit approvals/denials: Medicaid, homecare, SNAP, Section 8 housing, SCRIE/DRIE</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Discuss advance directives and client wishes for medical treatments, end-of-life care and funeral plans in advance</li> <li>Arrange for pre-paid funeral and burial in line with cultural and religious values</li> <li>Oversee and manage client's medical conditions and treatment – at home, and in nursing homes and hospitals</li> <li>24/7 TGP emergency phone line and client record access</li> <li>Arrange for hospice care in home or facility</li> <li>Review end-of-life wishes with family or friends, if necessary</li> <li>Make end-of-life decisions for the seriously ill (per the Family Health Care Decisions Act / FHCDA)</li> <li>Facilitate communication among various medical and ethical care providers for end-of-life care</li> <li>For the deceased - family notification, funeral and burial plans, religious observance</li> <li>Locate and execute last will and testament</li> <li>Obtain death certificate</li> <li>Arrange for funeral clothes when required</li> </ul>
